- Immunization requirements for the 2017/2018 school year have changed. All 12<sup>th</sup> graders will be required to have a meningococcal vaccine (meningitis) on/after the age of 16. The student Health Center will have the meningitis vaccine from now until the end of the school year. Proof of this immunization will be required before students can register in August.
