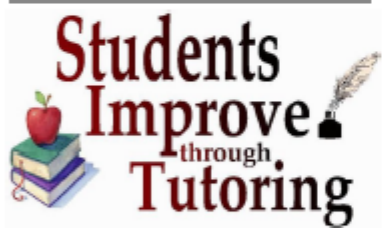


# PTHS TUTORING

### What is PTHS Tutoring?

Pontiac Township High School recognizes that students have different academic needs. As a result, PTHS offers tutoring in the library four days a week. Best of all, students are tutored by PTHS teachers. Most days, tutors include a math, a science, and an English teacher.

### When is PTHS tutoring available?

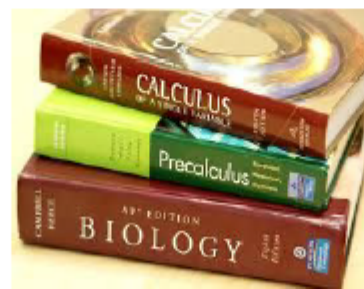
