- 2017-2018 Fees Information: **Freshman – Junior Classes** please have all fees paid in full before the last day of 2017-2018 school year, Thursday, May 24, 2018. All fees owed for the 2017-2018 and any prior school years need to be paid in full. Failure to do so can result in delayed registration for the 2018-2019 school year. Students need to check with Mrs. Bristow in the library prior to paying lost text book fees.
- **Attention Parents/Guardians:** The Class of 2019 immunization requirements for the 2018/2019 school year are as follows: All 12th graders will be required to have a meningococcal vaccine (meningitis) on/after the age of 16. The student Health Center will have the meningitis vaccine available from now until the end of the school year, if you would like your student to receive it while at school. We can bill your insurance; however, it is your responsibility to make sure your insurance will cover the cost. If you do not have insurance, the cost is \$20.
